

Cannot Connect to Oracle Database With Underscore in Table Name

Description

When attempting to set up connections in Loftware Design between my label and an Oracle database, tables with underscore (_) characters in the name are not visible.

Explanation

This is a known issue with version 8.0.4 of Oracle's ODBC driver.

Information

The issue has been resolved with the release of the latest version of the driver, which can be downloaded from [Oracle's web site](#).

The problem can also be avoided by using Microsoft's Oracle driver.
